Dominican Republic	Caribbean Tours	Tourist flights to and from the Dominican Republic have been resumed on July, 1.  The Ministry of Tourism and the Dominican Civil Aviation Authority, in coordination with the private sector, worked to establish protocols for the country's tourism industry to protect tourists' and staff's health. The Dominican Republic is now no longer on the list of risk countries for Switzerland, i. e. returnees to Switzerland are no longer required to undergo quarantine.	Travellers should check directly with the airline whether they need to carry out any tests or have any other requirements for visiting the Dominican Republic. <b>Cuba</b>	Caribbean Tours	Cuba has reopened its borders to international tourists as of July 2020. In Havana, phase 3 and transition to "new normality" will be effective immediately (October 12): restaurants, cafes, museums, galleries will be open again with 50% capacity for visitors. The beaches of Havana Playas del Este have also reopened with more space between the sunbeds. Beach destination Varadero is open again for international tourists as of October 15. The International Airport in Havana reopened for regular flights on Nov. 15. Cuba is no longer "risk area" for German tourists, meaning no self-isolation is needed after visiting Cuba. <b>From January 10, 2021, Cuba will require a certificate with a negative result of an RT-PCR for SARS Cov-2 made by a certified laboratory in the country of origin and carried out within a period of 72 hours before arrival on the island.</b>	Travellers must keep in mind that a medical travel insurance (covering eventual Covid-19 related problems) is compulsory to enter the country. Clients can choose the one that most suits their needs according to the length of stay and other factors. Should a passenger have a temperature of more than 37.5° C, he or she cannot enter the aircraft. It is advisable that clients are recommended to carry out a PCR a couple of days before departure, as they will not be able to enjoy their holidays in case of a positive PCR. <b>From January 10, 2021, Cuba will require a certificate with a negative result of an RT-PCR for SARS Cov-2 made by a certified laboratory in the country of origin and carried out within a period of 72 hours before arrival on the island.</b>	<b>Tourists must fill a Health Declaration form, indicating the address in Cuba (of the accommodation – hotel or casa) where the traveler can be reached during the first days after entering the country. All tourists are tested for possible infections by temperature measurement and Covid-19 PCR tests on arrival. All luggage get disinfected after arrival. In addition to the PCR test from the home country upon entry, there is an additional mandatory PCR-test at the airport in Cuba (regardless of the negative test result from the country of departure for all passengers.)</b> The result will be sent to the accommodation normally after approx. 24 hours. It is not allowed to leave the accommodation before receiving a NEGATIVE test result. During this period, the mask must also be worn at the accommodation. The traveler can move freely in all common areas of the accommodation (pool, bar, beach, etc.) within the first 24 hours of arrival while waiting for the negative result. After 24 hours with a negative result the traveler can freely explore and enjoy the city and travel to other provinces.	Tourist destination Varadero is open again for international tourists as of October 15. Flights to Havana are now allowed again. <b>Interprovincial visits are now allowed by all known means of transport, with the exception of the provinces of Pinar del Rio and Ciego de Avila. The province of Sancti Spiritus is now open again.</b> All other provinces are already in the phase of "nueva normalidad" due to the even lower number of cases, without neglecting the important safety protocols, such as wearing masks in all places, keeping a minimum distance and calling on the population to see a doctor immediately in case of any symptoms. The use of facemasks (known in Cuba as: "nasobuco") at the airport and in public places throughout the country is mandatory. Exceptionally, in hotels, it is allowed not to wear the mask in areas such as the beach, the swimming pool, and in places where social distance can be maintained. In gastronomic establishments it is compulsory to wear a facemask when entering the venue, but after ordering in a bar or at the hotel buffets guests can of course take it off.
