<b>Dominican Republic</b>	Caribbean Tours	Tourist flights to and from the Dominican Republic have been resumed on July, 1.  The Ministry of Tourism and the Dominican Civil Aviation Authority, in coordination with the private sector, worked to establish protocols for the country's tourism industry to protect tourists' and staff's health. The Dominican Republic is now no longer on the list of risk countries for Switzerland, i. e. returnees to Switzerland are no longer required to undergo quarantine.	Travellers should check directly with the airline whether they need to carry out any tests or have any other requirements for visiting the Dominican Republic. As of October 15, the beach destination of Varadero has been reopened to international tourism and as of November 15, Havana Airport has also reopened and traveling around the island is possible.</p> <p>The Cuban Ministry of Tourism (MINTUR) has updated the hygiene protocol to reduce the risk of contracting COVID-19.</p> <p>Cuba is not a "risk area" for tourists from Switzerland, meaning no self-isolation is needed after visiting Cuba. In Germany, Cuba was placed on the list of risk countries on 03.01.2021. There are quarantine regulations for returnees here (10 days of domestic isolation).</p>	<p>Since January 10, 2021, International travellers must present upon entry a certificate with a negative result of a PCR-RT test for SARS Cov-2 (in English language) prepared by a certified laboratory in the home country and performed within 72 hours prior to arrival on the island.</p> <p>An insurance with COVID-19 coverage is mandatory. If an insurance has not been obtained in the home country or its proof is not available upon entry, a cuban health insurance must be obtained at the Cuban airports upon entry for the duration of the stay.</p>	<p><b>In addition to the PCR test from the home country upon entry, additional mandatory PCR-test at the airport in Cuba (regardless of the negative test result from the country of departure for all passengers.) The result will be sent to the accommodation normally after approx. 24 hours. It is not allowed to leave the accommodation before receiving a NEGATIVE test result. (During this time same conditions as mentioned above, in the beach resorts they can move freely throughout the resort, in Havana and other cities, they are required to stay in their hotel room).</li> </ul>	<p>During travel – Current situation Cuba – Update 03/09/2021.</p> <p>The Covid 19 situation in Cuba has worsened somewhat in some provinces in recent weeks, which lead the government to implement some stricter measures to contain the pandemic. Nevertheless, compared to the infection outbreaks in North America or Europe, the case numbers remain relatively low. Furthermore, Cuba continues to be a safe travel destination.</p> <p>Entry into Cuba via the international airports (Havana and Varadero), as well as other provinces, is still possible for international tourists without restrictions.</p> <p>Some hotels and private accommodations are open in all provinces and international travellers can move from one province without any restrictions. Guests are allowed to stay in official accommodations (hotels and casas particulares) without any restrictions.</p> <p>Beach vacations in the most famous beach destinations like Varadero, Cayo Santa Maria or Cayo Coco are possible without restrictions and can be booked at very attractive conditions.</p> <p>Touristic round trips are basically possible and top spots like Viñales, Trinidad and Cienfuegos are accessible for the travellers.</p> <p>Round trips by rental car or cab to other provinces are possible. Public interprovincial bus service (such as Viazul) is not working at the moment.</p> <p>In the provinces or isolated districts of some provinces that are in "Phase 0" (phase with the greatest restriction, e. g. currently Havana), all tourist services (museums, galleries, nature reserves, nightlife, etc.) and also restaurants are closed and only offer delivery service or takeaway food. Exceptions apply in hotel areas, such as the beach or pool, where compliance with the distance rules (recommended minimum distance of 1.5 m) can be ensured. In restaurants, the mask must be worn when entering and leaving the restaurant, as well as in the buffet area and when ordering at the bar. Mask protection is also mandatory in restrooms. Since March 2021, it has also been possible to enter Costa Rica by land. It is possible to leave Panama for Costa Rica by land from April 5, 2021.	Prior to check-in, all incoming travelers will be required to complete an Electronic Affidavit (sworn statement) which will be available on <a href="https://www.panamadigital.gob.pa/Registro">https://www.panamadigital.gob.pa/Registro</a>	Temperature measurement on arrival in Panama. A Covid-19-test is mandatory for all travelers at their own expense (approx. 50 USD) at the airport. The test result is available about 30 minutes after the test; if the result is negative, the trip can be continued regularly. Surgical masks must be worn while at the airport. We highly recommend to every traveller to make a Covid-19-test before travelling to Panama. Important: When entering from South America, a PCR or antigen test must be submitted no older than 48 hours before departure to Panama. Furthermore, a further PCR or antigen test on arrival at the airport at cost of the travelers, as well as a subsequent 5-day quarantine in the apartment or hotel is mandatory. After five days, the quarantine can be ended with a further negative test (at cost of the travelers).	Most of the economic blocs were reactivated, following the hygiene protocols of each economic bloc. Depending on the region, travel may still be subject to certain restrictions, which can also be changed at short notice and depending on the infection rate. A curfew applies nationwide between 00:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m. National parks are open and are subject to a maximum number of daily visitors. Tickets for visiting the national park must be booked online at least 3 days in advance. Beaches are accessible daily from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Around 50% of the hotels are already open again. In the interior of the country, almost all tourist activities are possible again. In Panama City, the restrictions primarily relate to activities around the canal (train ride, canal trips, canal visitor centers closed) and San Blas.
