Dominican Republic	Caribbean Tours	All airports and tourist activities in the Dominican Republic have reopened, including the reactivation of air routes from Europe, Latin America, Canada and the United States.	Travelers are not required to present a negative test result for COVID-19 upon arrival. However, rapid tests will be performed on randomly selected travelers upon arrival. Passengers under the age of five and crew members are exempt from this requirement.	<p>To save time in the arrival procedure, we recommend filling out the entry form 72 hours before travel, printing out the QR code or taking a screenshot of it and keeping it ready until arrival, where it will be scanned by the authorities when the passenger is going through customs. Passengers must fill out one form for arrival and one form for departure and the system will generate two QR codes. The QR code will not be scanned upon departure, but it is confirmation that the form has been filled out correctly. If you want to make a change to the form, you will have to fill it out again. Until April 30, 2021, the Dominican authorities exceptionally accept both types of registrations for entry into the country: the previous one via physical forms and the new one via the digital system. From May 1, 2021, the use of digital forms will be mandatory and no other method of providing the information required to enter the Dominican Republic will be allowed or recognized as valid. The Dominican airports have free internet access so that passengers who have not completed the form before the flight can do so when they arrive in the country. Passengers arriving on private flights, non-commercial ships, ferries, cruise lines, etc. do not need to fill out the electronic form. The physical forms "Traveler's Health Affidavit", "Customs Declaration" and "International Embarkation / Disembarkation" are accepted for the aforementioned passengers.</p> <p>If you are staying for more than 30 days, expect an additional fee when you leave the country, which is based on the total length of your stay. You can view the corresponding fees here and upload the required documents. They must be paid online before departure or at the airport's immigration department – after check-in and security control – upon departure.</p>	<p>All airports, ports and tourist activities in the Dominican Republic have reopened. In addition to most all-inclusive hotels, most national parks and beaches have also opened. Furthermore, Cuba continues to be a safe travel destination.</p> <p>Entry into Cuba via the international airports (Havana and Varadero), as well as other provinces, is still possible for international tourists without restrictions.</p> <p>Some hotels and private accommodations are open in all provinces and international travellers can move from one province without any restrictions. After three days, the quarantine can be ended with a further negative test (at cost of the travelers).</p> <p>Travelers will be exempt from the 3-day mandatory quarantine and molecular test upon arrival provided that they present the following documents in physical or digital form: Negative COVID-19 PCR or antigen test taken no more than 72 hours prior to their arrival time in Panama. If a test is not possible within that time frame, a COVID-19 rapid test will be mandated at the airport before customs and the traveler will have to cover the costs of said test (USD \$50). Card or digital certification of a complete vaccination scheme endorsed by the WHO, EMA and FDA, equal to or greater than 14 days after the last dose</p>	<p>Most of the economic blocs were reactivated, following the hygiene protocols of each economic bloc.
